Covid-19 Update

Thank you to everyone for your cooperation and help in making 2020 a successful year through the pandemic! As we look to begin the 2021 season, on Thursday, April 1st, we will continue with most of the safety measures from last year. Since social distancing is impossible during the auction, masks will continue to be required in order to bid. Please check the list below for what to expect this season

- If you are feeling sick in any way, please do not come!
- Cover coughs and sneezes. Then go wash your hands!
- Masks are required to be in the main buyer crowd. You may bid without a mask if you distance yourself from others.
- If you bring someone to help you load your purchases, they should not enter the aisle where the auction is taking place. They should observe proper distancing until the auction has moved on.
- The office is for employees only. Customer service will happen through the windows. Please observe proper distancing while waiting.
- The Dry River Café will be open the whole season.
- Hand sanitizer is available in several places throughout the building. Better yet, wash your hands regularly in the restroom.
